

## **Proposed Amendments to the Bylaws, Creating Two New UFC Committees**

**These amendments would be inserted into ACA-05, Bylaws of the University Faculty Council of Indiana University, Section 12 (between items F and G).**

### **Student Affairs Committee**

The Student Affairs Committee (SAC) oversees matters pertaining to, or connected with, policies and practices related to students throughout Indiana University. The UFC-SAC will communicate with IUB, IUI, and regional campus's Student Affairs Committees and with the Office of the Vice President for Student Success. The committee should advise the Vice President for Student Success and the University Faculty Council on student matters, collaborate on university-wide plans for strengthening the students' education and experience, and, where appropriate, develop university-wide policies and procedures that aim to improve student success at Indiana University.

The executive committees of the campus faculty governing organizations shall appoint nine members to this committee, two from IU Bloomington, two from IU Indianapolis, one member each from IU East, IU Kokomo, IU Northwest, IU South Bend, and IU Southeast. The UFC-SAC will be co-chaired by a nominee of the IUB, IUI, and regional campuses.

Members should serve as liaisons to their campus's relevant faculty committees. Terms will be for 2 years, staggered.

### **Academic Affairs Committee**

The Academic Affairs Committee (AAC) oversees matters pertaining to, or connected with, policies and practices related to the academic enterprise throughout Indiana University. The UFC-AAC will communicate with IUB, IUI, and regional campus's Academic Affairs Committees and with the IU President's Academic Leadership Council. The committee should advise the Academic Leadership Council and the University Faculty Council on academic matters, collaborate on university-wide plans for strengthening the academic curriculum, and, where appropriate, develop university-wide policies and procedures that aim to improve academics at Indiana University. A standing Online Education Subcommittee, appointed by the UFC Executive Committee, will report to the AAC.

The executive committees of the campus faculty governing organizations shall appoint nine members to this committee, two from IU Bloomington, two from IU Indianapolis, one member each from IU East, IU Kokomo, IU Northwest, IU South Bend, and IU Southeast. The Online Education Subcommittee will appoint one committee member. The UFC-AAC will be co-chaired by a nominee of the IUB, IUI, and regional campuses.

Members should serve as liaisons to their campus's relevant faculty committees. Terms will be for 2 years, staggered.
